We have also provided useful telephone numbers and anything we think you may need to make your stay with us more pleasant.

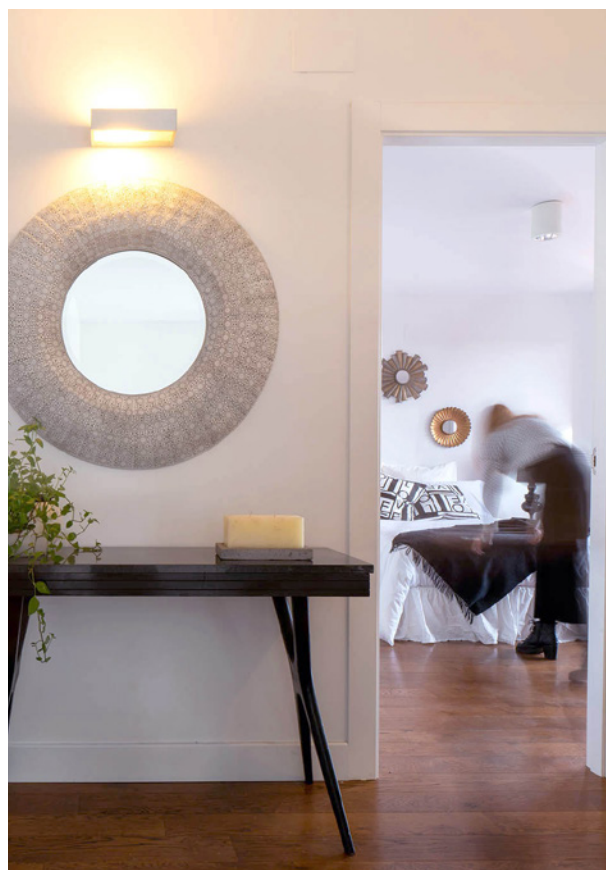
We hope that your time here is filled with positive experiences, that you relax and disconnect – and also that you take the opportunity to get to know the area.

House Rules

PARTIES

Parties are not permitted. Our house is a meeting place within the village, and we want everyone to **respect the peacefulness of the area and not bother neighbors, or other clients**, as the common space with the pool and the garden is shared with another apartment.

GUESTS

Only the reserved number of guests can stay. The numbers cannot exceed the capacity of each building, **except in the case of children under the age of two.**

SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited in the house. You can smoke in the garden, and we would ask that care is taken with cigarette butts, and ash.

SWIMMING POOL

We make every effort to keep the swimming pool clean and in good condition. **We would ask that you do not put anything from outside into the pool area**, and not to enter the pool with footwear.

PETS

We accept pets up to 10 kg, and we ask that owners be responsible. Acceptance of pets must be previously approved.

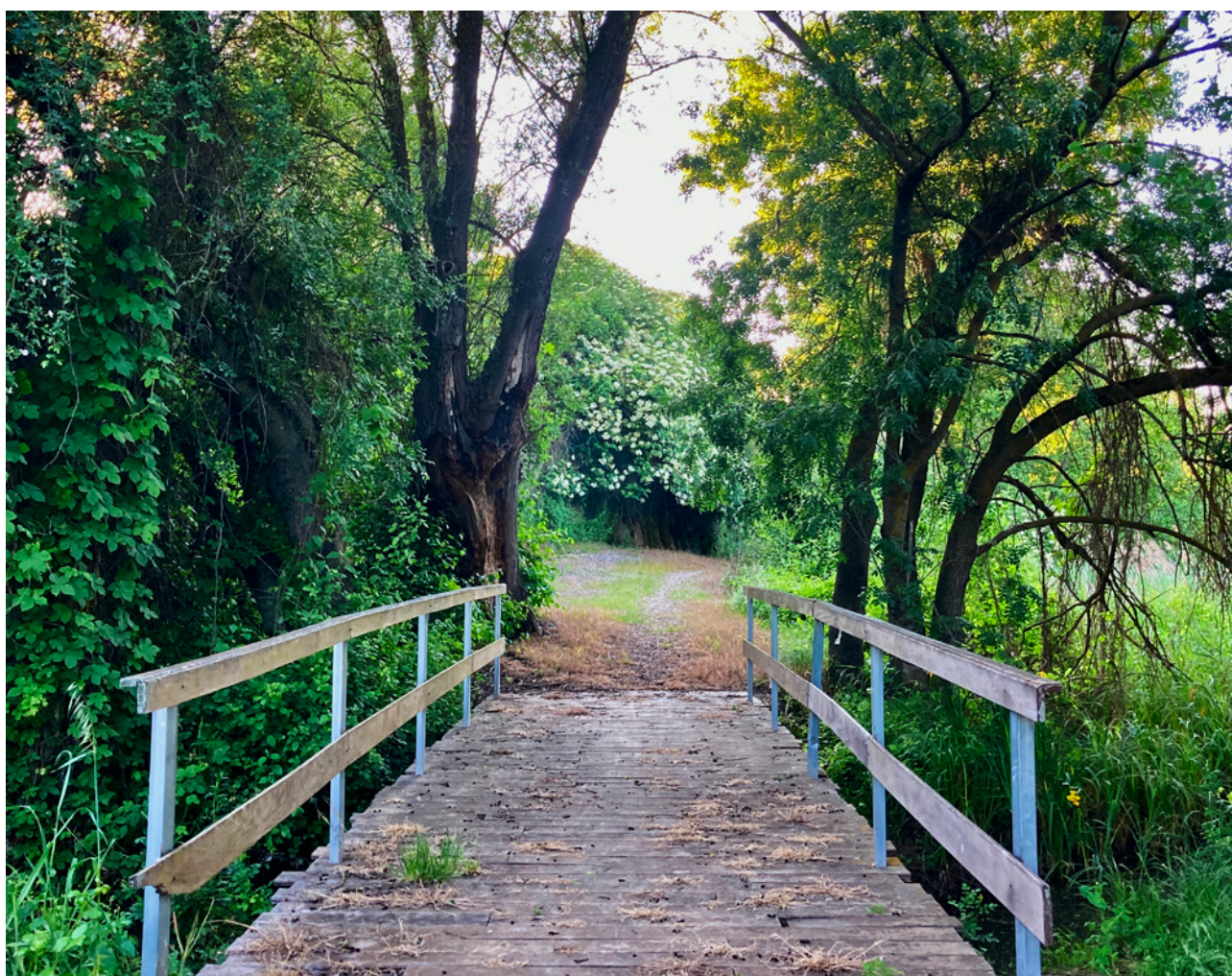

Vadocondes and surroundings



What to do in Vadocondes and Aranda de Duero (10 km away)?

We have the perfect location for you to enjoy endless activities – from visits to the world famous wineries of the Ribera del Duero, the historic buildings in Vadocondes and the local area. For a more active break there are great walks, cycle routes or even canoeing.

WALKING

Just outside the front door **there are many great options for walking**, such as walks through the vineyards, or the GR-14 river path alongside the Duero, a path well known for its ecological and natural beauty.

CYCLING

The riverbank and the area surrounding the house offer **many possibilities for doing cycle routes**. **If you need to hire bikes, we can organize in advance.**

CANOEING

If the river is what calls to you, the Duero is perfect for canoeing. There is a small pier in the village, giving access to the river.



ENOTOURISM

The village still retains some of the old wine cellars and “lagares”, which you can visit. In addition, we are in the heart of the Ribera del Duero, perfect for visiting the wineries on the wine route of the Ribera del Duero.

CULTURAL INTEREST

Vadocondes has a **long history, and many buildings of cultural interest**. And you should not miss the sights in the surrounding area such as the Monastery in La Vid, the beautiful town of Peñaranda del Duero and the underground wine cellars in Aranda de Duero.

GASTRONOMY

And you cannot leave the area without trying the suckling lamb cooked in a wood fired oven, or over the vine cuttings, the local bread, the black or blood pudding, and of course, the wines from the Ribera del Duero.



What to see in Vadocondes?



Vadocondes is full of surprises.



Our little village, **of 300 inhabitants**, is only 10 km from **Aranda de Duero**, in the **Ribera del Duero, Burgos**. Despite its current low population, it has a great historic legacy, and **has been declared “of Cultural Interest” in the Historical Complex category since 1988**.

We invite you to stroll around and discover our beautiful village.

What to see in Vadocondes:



1. The new Gate, the Burgos Gate and the medieval town wall.
2. Church of Our Lady of the Assumption.
3. The main square.
4. Traditional architecture.
5. Bridge over the River Duero.
6. The dry bridge.
7. The iron bridge.
8. The hermitages of San Cosme and San Damián, and the hermitage of Humilladero.
9. The traditional wine cellars.
10. The GR-14 walking route and recreational arearecreativa.



What to see in Aranda de Duero?

Our house is only 10 km from Aranda de Duero, and we recommend you don't miss the opportunity to visit.

Aranda de Duero is the centre of the Burgos part of the Ribera del Duero, and one of the most emblematic towns in the region. It is known for its wines and wine cellars, and for the gastronomic excellence, with suckling roast lamb being the stellar offering. In addition, the historic and cultural buildings in Aranda are spectacular.

We recommend:

1. Underground wine cellars.
2. The Main square and adjoining streets.
3. Trigo square and Isilla street.
4. Church of Santa María La Real.
5. Church of San Juan.
6. House of Bolas.
7. Tenerías Romanesque bridge.
8. Rollo Square.
9. Train Museum.

Don't leave Aranda without trying the delicious traditional suckling lamb, roasted in wood fired ovens, and accompanied by the traditional bread, and of course, a full bodied wine from the Ribera del Duero. Calle Isilla has numerous restaurants to choose from.

Recommended Wineries

BODEGAS VALSOTILLO

★★★★★ 4,8

Family run winery from the XVI century in Sotillo de la Ribera, 15 km from Aranda de Duero. It is considered to be one of the Cathedrals of wine in the Ribera del Duero, with 1200 m² of underground cellars, carved into the rock.

BODEGA MARTIN BERDUGO

★★★★★ 4,7

A family run winery with a long wine making tradition, situated on the outskirts of Aranda, with fabulous views of the vineyards.

BODEGAS PORTIA

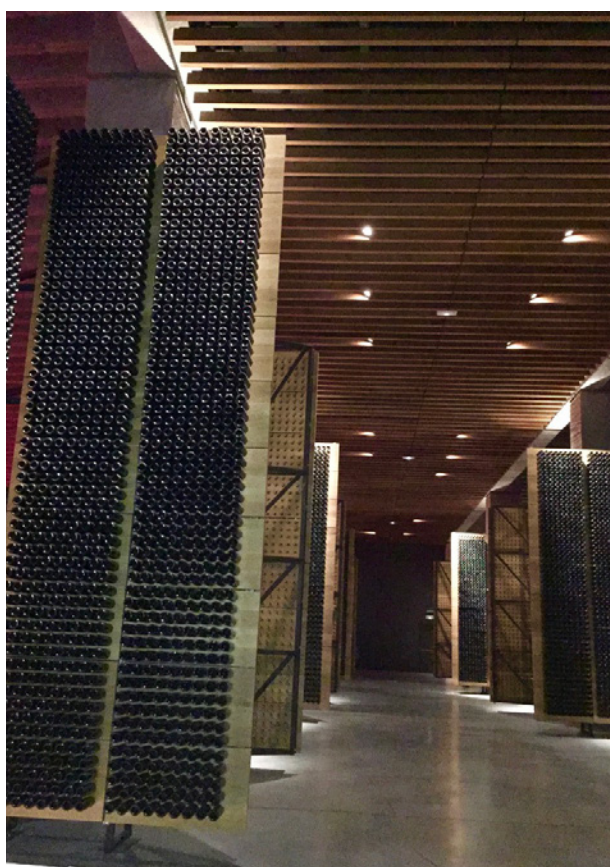
★★★★★ 4,5

The winery was designed by the English architect, Norman Foster. It belongs to the Faustino group and is an icon of modern architecture in the Ribera del Duero.

BODEGA HISTÓRICA DON CARLOS

★★★★★ 4,5

A historic fifteenth century cellar in the heart of Aranda de Duero. It is part of the underground city under Aranda de Duero.



What to visit in the surrounding area?

LA VID MONASTERY

The Monastery of Santa María de La Vid, **is in La Vid, 18 km from Aranda de Duero, 8 km from Vadocondes.**

It is a beautiful monastery setting, **founded in the 12th century with an impressive library, a museum specializing in religious art,** and another museum with a large collection of coins and old medals.

PEÑARANDA DE DUERO

Peñaranda de Duero is one of the prettiest villages in Burgos. It has a spectacular historic walled centre.

We recommend that you stroll through the streets and alleys, and climb the hill to the fifteenth century castle to see spectacular views of the surrounding countryside.

GUMIEL DE HIZAN

Gumiel de Hizan is another **charming village very close to Aranda de Duero, and declared “of Cultural and artistic Interest”** in the Historical Complex category.

It is worth walking through the streets to appreciate the traditional architecture, and in addition there are wineries to visit, such as Portia.

ROA DE DUERO

This town also has an **extensive historic and cultural heritage, such as the Puente Mayor,** the former collegiate of Our Lady of Assumption, the remains of the **medieval wall from the 13th century, and the Archeological park.**

To get spectacular views, it is worth taking a walk up to the Balcony of the Duero lookout.



PEÑAFIEL

This pretty town, **in the province of Valladolid, is overlooked by an impressive castle, now converted into a wine museum.** The views from the summit are incredible.

In addition to **the famous Plaza del Coso, bordered by traditional houses,** take a stroll around the old centre to visit the Churches of Sta María and of San Miguel de Reoyo.

SAN ESTEBAN DE GORMAZ

San Esteban de Gormaz **is in the province of Soria, and the town centre has been declared of Cultural and historic interest.** If you like Romanesque architecture then you have to visit the **San Miguel and Santa María del Rivero churches.** There is also a Romanesque theme park. If you have the time, visit the underground wine cellar area, and the traditional “lagares”.



HAZA

Haza **is a village with less than 50 inhabitants, placed on the top of a hill facing south, near Roa and Aranda de Duero. It is of great historic significance as it was one of the first villages repopulated by the Christian advance of the 10th century – and it was awarded the title of Villa.**

It is worthwhile visiting the walled town and the castle.

MADERUELO

Maderuelo **is an historic town in the province of Segovia.** In addition to the Cultural, Artistic and Historic value, **we can also appreciate the spectacular natural environment.** The town is perched on a hill and surrounded by the Linares reservoir. **This beautiful medieval town is listed amongst “The most beautiful towns in Spain”.**
